# START DAYS AND TIMES FOR SEPTEMBER



Your child will be starting school for their first session on:

- Tuesday 5th September 8.50am to 11.30pm (children start school for a short session only.)
- Wednesday 6th September 8.50am to 1.30pm (children are staying for lunch).
- Thursday 7th September onwards 8.50am to 3.20pm (children stay all day).
- From Thursday 7th September, your child will attend school full time. Our school hours are 8.50am until 3.20pm.
- Drop off and collection is at our Foundation classroom door.

### WELLBEING



Your child will be welcomed into the setting by three very nurturing professionals. Our mission is to
ensure that the emotional and social areas of development are a focus and that your children can feel
at home in our setting.

### PARENTS AND CARERS



Staff work in partnership with you so that your child will have the best school experience possible. We keep a record for your child in school to celebrate their achievements in Foundation. We use observational evidence and also share things via various apps.

You will receive updates regularly via our social media, Facebook, Instagram and twitter, email, our whole school app, Seesaw and our EYFS assessment app that we use to observe the children in school. You will receive email updates about your children and you can send us things from home too!

Any 'wow' moments are welcome and we love to share every achievement, big or small.

We will hold regular enjoy and explore sessions at different times of year where you can join us for fun activities with your child.

### **OUR SCHOOL DAY...**

Our doors open at 08.50am and your child will be welcomed on the door by one of the Foundation teaching staff.

We will help the children find their pegs and put their things away.

During the first part of the morning, your child will take part in phonics sessions and will also be able to lead their own learning in our provision.

We will also have snack around 10am where we provide fruit, cereal or you can add money to pay for toast.

The children will continue with a maths session and then go for their lunch at I 1.50am.

At Ipm the children will return and we will have various learning sessions about a range of topics, literacy and again, lead their own learning in the provision.

We call it 'leading our learning' to coincide with our school values of 'collaborate, achieve, respect and enjoyment.' The school day finishes at 3.20pm where the children can be collected from our Foundation door.

# THE EARLY YEAR'S FOUNDATION STAGE (EYFS)



Activities in Foundation are carefully planned and organised in order to provide a range of learning experiences. Individual records are kept on an app by staff to record the activities your child participates in and undertakes, as well as their progress in specific skills.

Planning for each term and week is carried out using a topic-based approach, following the children's interests and responding to specific events.

There are 7 Areas of Learning in the Early Years Foundation Stage (EYFS), which activities are planned around:

- Personal, Social and Emotional Development
- Physical Development
- Communication and Language
- Literacy
- Maths
- Understanding the World
- Expressive Arts and Design

Throughout the EYFS, children will be working towards the Early Learning Goals. These describe the level of attainment expected at the end of your child's Reception year in school.

# THE IMPORTANT BITS TO REMEMBER...



- Homework Children will be set homework through our Seesaw app We encourage you to share photos on Seesaw these are shared and celebrated in class.
- Reading
   — We send a reading
   record home and ask that you
   write a comment or sign each time
   you read with your child. Please
   bring your child's book bag to
   school every day.

- Children's names must be put inside all their items— this includes, clothes, shoes, t shirts, PE kits, coats EVERYTHING!
- Spare clothes if possible please can you send some spare underwear, and socks/tights in a bag for your child to keep on their peg in case they need to get changed.

Every child in the class will be provided with a Murdishaw West CP book bag this year for free!
