Features of a Church

Although lots of churches are very different, you will find some or all of these features in most Christian churches.

Lots of churches are made in the shape of a cross.



Lots of churches have a **bell tower** that has **bells** ringing at different times.

Cross - sometimes they will have Jesus on them, this is called a **crucifix**.

Altar - the table in the Christian church.

Lectern - a stand where the bible is read from.

Font - a large bowl that has holy water in it to baptise babies.



Stained glass windows - colourful windows made into pictures—usually showing a bible story.

Pulpit - where the priest stands to talk to the people.

Pews - a long bench for people coming to church to sit on.
